## SIDE EVENT OG WEEK 2023: MEWAJUDKAN KO-KREASI DAN KOLABORASI DALAM SETIAP TINGKATAN PEMERINTAH

Jakarta - (10/3) – Sekretariat Nasional Open Government Indonesia (OGI) berkolaborasi dengan mitra Kementerian/Lembaga (K/L) dan Organisasi Masyarakat Sipil (OMS) menyelenggarakan rangkaian acara side event dalam rangka Open Government Week (OG Week) 2023. OG Week merupakan kegiatan yang dilaksanakan setiap tahun pada bulan Mei secara global oleh negara-negara anggota Open Government Partnership (OGP). Kegiatan ini memberikan kesempatan bagi aktor pemerintah dan nonpemerintah membagikan pengalaman dan pengetahuannya terkait dampak serta praktik baik keterbukaan pemerintah. Rangkaian kegiatan OG Week telah berhasil dilangsungkan dari mulai tanggal 10-16 Mei 2023 dengan mengumpulkan para reformis keterbukaan pemerintah untuk membagikan ide, mendiskusikan solusi, dan menguatkan komitmen untuk meningkatkan kontribusi aktif dalam pelaksanaan keterbukaan pemerintah.

Jakarta - (10/3) – The Open Government Indonesia (OGI) National Secretariat held a series of side events in collaboration with Ministries/Institutions and Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) to commemorate Open Government Week (OG Week) 2023. OG Week is an annual event that is held globally in May among the Open Government Partnership (OGP) member countries. This event is an opportunity for state and non-state actors to share their knowledge and experience related their good practices and impacts in implementing open governance. The series of events for OG Week were successfully held in Indonesia from the 10th-16th of May 2023 by gathering open government reformers to share ideas, discuss solutions, and strengthen joint commitments to actively contribute to the implementation of open governance.

Pada OG Week 2023, Sekretariat Nasional OGI mengusung tema utama "Pekan Keterbukaan Pemerintah: Mewujudkan Ko-kreasi dan Kolaborasi pada Setiap Tingkatan Pemerintah." Serangkaian kegiatan dilakukan melalui kolaborasi aktif antar Sekretariat Nasional OGI, K/L, dan OMS melalui diselenggarakannya 9 (sembilan) side event dalam lingkup keterbukaan pemerintah. Perwakilan K/L, OMS, sektor swasta, kelompok penyandang disabilitas, mahasiswa, dan perwakilan lainnya turut hadir untuk memeriahkan pelaksanaan side event OG Week 2023 yang diselenggarakan secara luring di Hotel Grand Hyatt dan daring melalui Zoom. Beragamnya latar belakang peserta dalam OG Week 2023 menunjukkan inklusivitas penyelenggaraan pada setiap kegiatan OG Week 2023 di Indonesia.

Rangkaian kegiatan OG Week ini dihadiri oleh lebih dari 1.000 peserta dengan total komposisi peserta sebanyak 53% wanita dan 47% laki-laki. Side Event OG Week 2023 terdiri atas webinar, Focus Group Discussion, Pelatihan, dan Perlombaan, yang diselenggarakan secara ko-kreasi antara Sekretariat Open Government Indonesia dengan Kementerian Komunikasi dan Informatika (Kominfo), Lembaga Kebijakan Pengadaan Barang dan Jasa Pemerintah (LKPP), Lembaga Perlindungan Saksi dan Korban (LPSK), Yayasan TIFA, Yayasan Indonesia untuk Kemanusiaan, United Cities and Local Government Asia Pacific (UCLG ASPAC), Yayasan Auriga, Asosiasi LBH APIK, Perhimpunan Bantuan Hukum dan HAM Indonesia (PBHI), Indonesia Judicial Research Society (IJRS), Indonesia Center For Environmental Law (ICEL), Suarise, dan International NGO Forum for Indonesia Development (INFID).

The OGI National Secretariat held this year's OG Week with the main theme "Open Government Week: Actualizing Co-Creation and Collaboration in Every Level of Governance". The series of events were carried out through active collaboration between the OGI National Secretariat, Ministries/Institutions, and CSOs by organizing 9 side events. Representatives from Ministries/Institutions, CSOs, private sectors, persons with disabilities, students, and other stakeholders also attended to commemorate the event offline at the Grand Hyatt Hotel and online through the Zoom platform. The diverse background of participants is a testament to the event's inclusivity.

The series of OG Week side events were attended by more than 1.000 participants with a total composition of 53% women and 47% men. The side events were comprised of webinars, focus group discussions, trainings and competitions which were held through co-creation between several stakeholders, namely the Ministry of Communication and Information, National Public Procurement Agency, Indonesia Witness and Victim Protection Agency, TIFA Foundation, Yayasan Indonesia untuk Kemanusiaan, United Cities and Local Government Asia Pacific, Auriga Foundation, LBH APIK Association, Indonesian Legal Aid and Human Rights Association (PBHI), Indonesia Judicial Research Society (IJRS), Indonesia Center For Environmental Law (ICEL), Suarise, and the International NGO Forum for Indonesia Development (INFID).

Setelah kegiatan ini, Sekretariat Nasional OGI akan menindaklanjuti beberapa aspirasi dengan dua strategi utama, yakni, pertama, berpartisipasi secara aktif dan berdampak pada setiap pelaksanaan target capaian Rencana Aksi Nasional Open Government Indonesia (RAN OGI) VII. Melalui masukan dalam rangkaian OG Week 2023, Sekretariat OGI akan memfasilitasi serta memberikan masukan-masukan kepada seluruh pemangku kepentingan, sebagai upaya memastikan aspirasi dalam seluruh rangkaian OG Week 2023 terakomodasi. Kedua, memperkuat pelaksanaan monitoring dan evaluasi pelaksanaan setiap komitmen dalam RAN OGI VII untuk memastikan seluruh ukuran keberhasilan dapat tercapai dan memastikan dilaksanakannya prinsip-prinsip keterbukaan pemerintah serta ko-kreasi antara pemerintah dan unsur non-pemerintah dapat terlaksana.

Following this event, the OGI National Secretariat will follow up on some of the aspirations gathered through OG Week by adapting two main strategies. Firstly, the OGI National Secretariat will actively be involved in the 7th National Action Plan (OGI NAP) implementation. Through the inputs gathered from the event, the OGI National Secretariat will facilitate meetings and provide inputs to stakeholders to ensure that all the aspirations from OG Week 2023 are accommodated. Secondly, the OGI National Secretariat will strengthen monitoring and evaluation of commitments in the 7th OGI NAP to ensure that targets are achieved and that open government principles as well as co-creation between government and non-government are carried out.
